Part-Time Bus Driver

Job Description

Cheakamus Centre has an immediate opening for a reliable, experienced part time bus driver who enjoys working with children and youth. This is an ideal job for semi or retired people living in the Sea to Sky who are committed to safety, customer service and working in a school community.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

Drivers must be attentive to city and highway traffic and changing weather conditions, while staying on schedule and ensuring the safety of high school-aged passengers. Drivers must ensure that their vehicles are operating properly each day by conducting pre- and post-trip vehicle inspections, and maintaining the vehicle in a safe and clean condition. Drivers are also responsible for checking in students, maintaining a safe environment on the bus by enforcing rules of conduct, and responding to emergencies.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

The Driver is responsible for picking up and returning the bus to Cheakamus Centre at the end of each run. A clean Class 4 Unrestricted Driver's License, Driver's Abstract, and current RCMP background check are required. Mechanical knowledge of vehicles is an asset.

Job Term

Typical shifts are Monday or Tuesday, 5am – 9am and Thursday or Friday, 2pm – 6pm, with an average of 8 hours per week (October – mid-May).

Job Location

The Driver is responsible for twice-weekly runs between Cheakamus Centre in Brackendale and North Vancouver.
