

Classrooms to Communities (C2C) Provincial Professional Development Conference: Connecting People, Place & Planet

Re-thinking K-12 Teaching and Learning in BC Schools

VANCOUVER, BC, OCTOBER, 2019 — Over 325 educators, including teachers, students and community members from across the province, gathered October 25-26 to explore inspiring and community-connected strategies for teaching and learning in B.C. schools.

"Place-based learning is as core foundation of the renewed K-12 curriculum in B.C." said Patrick Robertson, Chair of the C2C Education Network, "Our provincial network aims to support teacher collaboration, leadership and professional development as we showcased at this conference, Connecting to People, Place and Planet."

On location at UBC and other venues across Metro Vancouver, promising practices and approaches for transformative teaching and learning in B.C. schools were celebrated. Hosted by C2C-BC, the two-day conference modeled innovative and collaborative approaches to using the community as an extension of the classroom. It provided opportunities for professional learning, inquiry and collaboration, including:

- Over 50 engaging sessions, workshops and networking activities on campus, at parks, school gardens, local businesses and other regional learning hubs
- A full day of rich and varied community-based field experiences around the region
- Inspiring storytellers and leaders from diverse local and provincial organizations, including educators, academics, teacher educators, researchers, administrators, policy makers, graduate students and teacher candidates
